Luís Jerónimo é diretor do Programa Gulbenkian Desenvolvimento Sustentável desde janeiro 2020. Integra a Fundação Calouste Gulbenkian desde 2006, tendo trabalhado na Delegação do Reino Unido da Fundação, tendo sido diretor adjunto do Programa Gulbenkian Desenvolvimento Humano, entre 2017 e 2018 e diretor do Programa Gulbenkian Coesão e Integração Social e do Programa Gulbenkian Sustentabilidade, em 2019. Atualmente é membro do *Board of Directors da European Venture Philanthropy Association* e administrador não executivo da MAZE, startup dedicada ao investimento de impacto criada pela Fundação Calouste Gulbenkian.

É licenciado em Filosofia pela Faculdade de Ciências Sociais e Humanas da Universidade Nova de Lisboa, tendo concluído em 2013 o INSEAD *Social Entrepreneurship Programme* e em 2015 o *General Management Programme na Judge Business School*, da Universidade de Cambridge.

Luís Jerónimo is the Director of the “Programa Gulbenkian Desenvolvimento Sustentável” (Gulbenkian Sustainable Development Program) since January 2020. He has been a member of the Calouste Gulbenkian Foundation since 2006, having worked in the United Kingdom Delegation of that Foundation. Between 2017 and 2018 he was deputy Director of the Gulbenkian Human Development Programme and Director of the Gulbenkian Cohesion and Social Integration Programme and the Gulbenkian Sustainability Programme in 2019. He is currently a member of the Board of Directors of the European Venture Philanthropy Association and non-executive director of MAZE , a startup dedicated to the impact investment created by the Calouste Gulbenkian Foundation. He holds a degree in Philosophy from the “Faculdade de Ciências Sociais e Humanas da Universidade Nova de Lisboa” (Faculty of Social and Human Sciences of the Nova University of Lisbon), having completed the INSEAD Social Entrepreneurship Programme in 2013 and in 2015 the General Management Programme at the Judge Business School, University of Cambridge.
